The <u>heavenly</u> realms are the invisible realities of our life now.

THE FATHER

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ. For he 1 chose us in Him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in His sight. In love 2 He predestined us to be adopted as His sons through Jesus Christ in accordance with His pleasure and will to the praise and glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One He loves.

JESUS

In Him 3 we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace that He lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding. And 4 He made known to us the mystery of His will according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment – to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ. 5 in him we were also chosen, having been predestined according to the plan of Him who works out everything in conformity with the purpose of His will, in order that we, who were the first to hope in Christ, might be for the praise of His glory. And you also were 6 included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation.

HOLY SPIRIT

Having believed, you were 7 marked in Him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit, who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance until the redemption of those who are God's possession – to the praise of His glory." Eph. 1:4-14 (NIV)
