II. THE SETTING ASIDE OF ISRAEL IS ONLY PARTIAL NOT COMPLETE. (vs. 1-10)

PAUL'S 3 PROOFS:

1. Paul himself (vs. 1)
2. There is a remnant of true believing Jews. (vs. 2-5a)
3. They were chosen by grace. (vs. 5b-6)

Israel disciplined but not completely rejected (vs. 7-10)

III. THE SETTING ASIDE OF ISRAEL IS ONLY TEMPORARY NOT COMPLETE. (vs. 11-36)

WHY WERE THEY SET ASIDE? (vs. 11-16)

1. So that the Gentiles would be saved.

2. To make Israel envious.

3. To open a new channel of blessing to the world- The Church.

(vs. 17-24)

Until the full number of Gentiles has come in.
